Summer Radio Camps

A four day workshop that teaches you how to build a 40 watt FM broadcast transmitter (and other related items such as antennas) and set up a low power community radio station capable of covering a broadcast radius up to 10 miles depending on terrain and antenna height. With an emphasis on direct, hands-on learning, you will learn how to solder, identify electronic components, assemble a 40 watt transmitter from a kit of parts, build and tune an antenna, properly setup and test broadcast equipment and much more. Further, you will be given an overview of basic electronics and broadcast engineering.

A workshop fee of \$200-\$250 sliding scale is charged. At the end of the radio camp session you may purchase the 40 watt transmitter for \$350 - the cost of the kit, power supply and enclosure.

Camps are open to anyone 14 years and older. Radio Camp sessions run Friday through Monday (10 a.m. to 6 p.m.). They are held at FRB's facility in Oakland, CA on the following dates:

July 4 - July 7, 2008
August 1 - 4, 2008
August 29 - September 1, 2008
